——What Do You Need To Follow Before Submitting Your Paper?

Accepted submission papers are divided into two categories: one is essays on theoretical research and the other is study on practical problems. Some authors assume that our accepted papers must adopt as many as models or methods or complex mathematical formulas. However, it is mistaken. Therefore, we remind authors the following guidelines:

First, Clear about your paper. Is it a study on practical problems or theoretical research? If it is the former, you need to focus on thorough analysis of the problem while paths and methods must obey the problem. If it's the latter, you'd better work on plan design or improvement explanation. What's more, you must prove your demonstration method practical and feasible by evidence or cases. The content and layout must be tailored based on categories of the paper.

Second, Whether the paper is superb doesn't lie in models or methods. Therefore, we stress quantitative methods but methods or models are not decisive factors. Models and methods must respond to theme of the essay and necessity of research in a satisfactory paper, rather than piled up or overused.
