——What Kind Of Paper Does Our Journal Need?

There are two principles we follow to choose papers: selected topics and logic. First, there must be theoretical or practical significance in the selected topic. Next, logic in the paper must be clear and demonstrated under the selected topic. Some authors constantly submit their papers to our journal without being accepted for several reasons: meaningless topics, vague themes, logically unreasonable or irrelevant between the content and title. Therefore, we remind authors of the following guidelines:

First, there must be significance in the chosen topic. You can refer to website of National Social Science Fund and focus on topics of major bidding projects in recent years. It's a good idea to combine what you are good at in your field and those topics. You can also submit your paper according to our requirements.

Second, the topic must be concise and clear in meaning. It must convey main idea of the paper. Thus, author must spare no efforts to choose the best topic.

Third, the paper must be clear and well-organized in logic. It must be demonstrated to the point instead of beside the point, or rather far away from the point.

We think academic writing is not production of self-entertainment of writer. Researches and studies must be carried to cater for needs of our country and society. Therefore, the proposition must be practical and useful. We won't care for what any scholars are good at or special research interests of writers
